



(3 cr) **Experiential learning:**

Students will engage in the process(es) of entrepreneurship to earn experiential learning credits. Entrepreneurial processes include 1) identifying an opportunity, 2) developing a concept; 3) determining required resources; 4) acquiring the necessary resources; 5) implementing and managing the concept; and 6) harvesting the venture. Students will submit a written proposal to the Entrepreneurship Supervisory Committee explaining how their proposed activity relates to entrepreneurial processes. This must be done prior to the activity to receive pre-approval for the experiential learning credits. Students may use existing courses, internships, consulting projects, or independent studies to meet this requirement as long as there are significant applicable entrepreneurial experiential activities, as judged by the Entrepreneurship Supervisory Committee.

Students desiring to take courses other than those listed must seek approval from the Entrepreneurship Supervisory Committee. Similarly, transfer students who desire to transfer in entrepreneurship courses and have them count toward completion of the minor have to follow the routine process of verifying course transfer into Iowa State University.
