Evolved over time...

The IVCEC made its debut in 2000. Since then it has attracted more than 300 persons annually. The John Pappajohn Entrepreneurial Centers (JPECs), Iowa Department of Economic Development (IDED) and businesses hosted the first conference. Now, entrepreneurs, trade associations and investors have joined the sponsorship list.

At the first conference, Mr. John Pappajohn, entrepreneur and philanthropist, announced that he would provide \$5,000 in seed money awards to students or student teams. This program continues through the JPECs.

Mr. Pappajohn launched the Iowa Business Plan Competition in 2006 and has donated \$50,000 each year for the past three years to be used as start up seed money for the business plans voted the top three in the competition. This competition is designed to stimulate business development and provide recognition to outstanding businesses. The competition winners are announced at the annual conference.
